PROGRESS REPORT: YEAR 9

The **Most Likely Grade** shows the grade (9 to 1) that your child is most likely to achieve at the end of Year 11, according to the professional opinion of the teacher, if they continue to progress at a good rate.

The report also presents a **Current Grade**, which shows a teacher assessment of the grade your child is currently working at.

The **Attitude to Learning** comment relayed in the report gives an indication of your child's approach to study. This takes in to account their behaviour, effort, organisation, engagement and desire to learn.
